Scott graduated from North Carolina State University with a degree in Mechanical Engineering. Scott celebrated 29 years with General Electric and was GE's General Manager Southeast Caribbean. Scott came to faith in Christ in 2011 and was a member of Good News Church-World Golf Village.

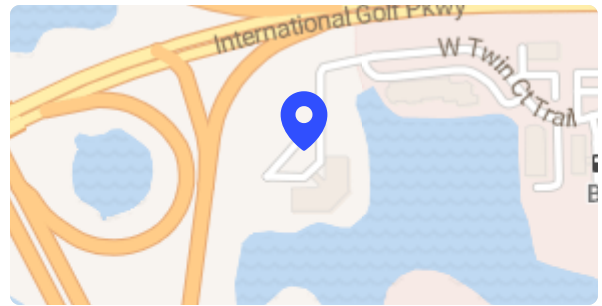

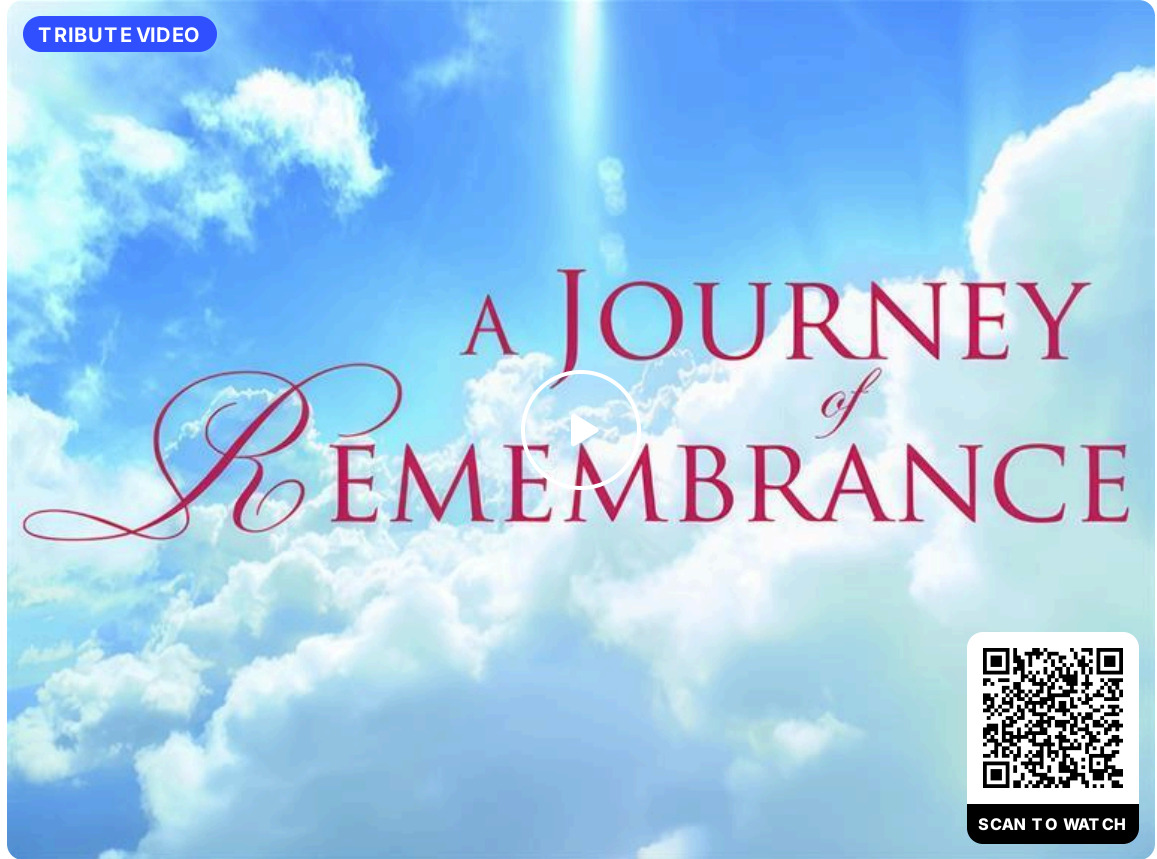
