When Louise was younger, her favorite activities were reading, drawing, painting, and caring for her pets. Later in life she married and had children and was very socially active in her community and went on to own her own pet grooming business before pursuing her passion for writing. Louise was a self-taught artist and author whose passion for writing and illustrating children's books began in early childhood.
