Richard Armand La France May 15, 1947 – June 5, 2025

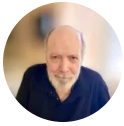
With heavy hearts, we announce that Richard Armand La France went to be with the Lord on June 5, 2025, at the age of 78, surrounded by family.
