Paul Henry Weber, 82, passed away on September 12, 2025, around 11 p.m. at AdventHealth Hospice Care Center in Palm Coast, Florida.

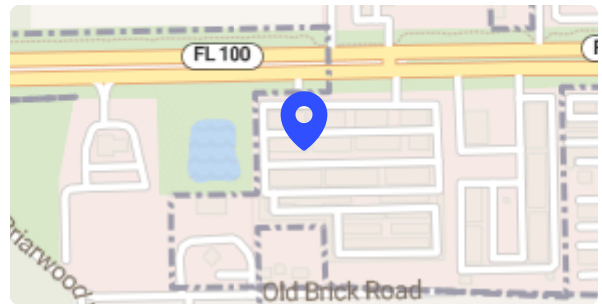

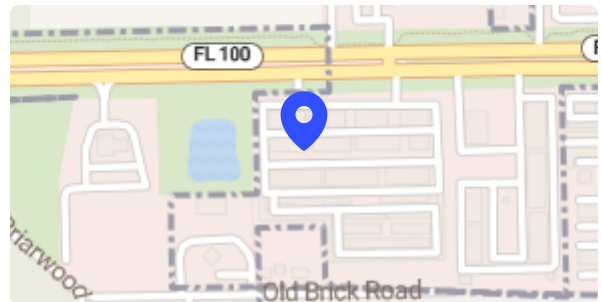

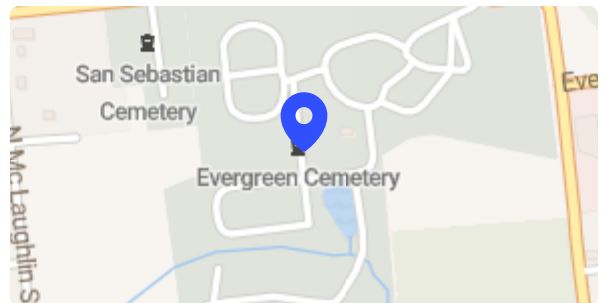
