**W**ith saddened hearts, we announce the passing of John Unger, age 92. John was born on June 6, 1933, in Bakonyjako, Hungary, to the late John and Maria Unger. He and his family later moved to Germany, where he lived until May of 1952.

In 1956, John married the love of his life, Rose, with whom he shared many wonderful years until her passing on November 23, 2012. Together, they built a beautiful life, including their home on top of the mountain in New Jersey. John was self-employed in home construction and took great pride in his work.

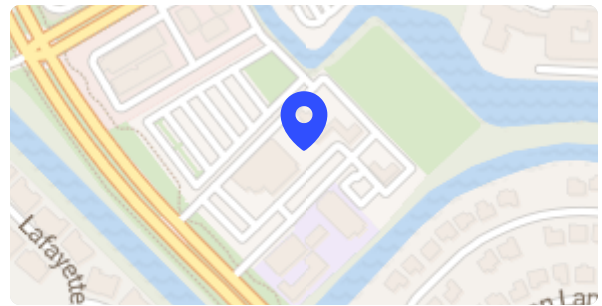
