**R**ichard “Rick” Trowbridge, 56, of Palm Coast, passed away on March 22, 2026. Rick was born in Miami, Florida on August 22, 1969, and was the youngest of four siblings. Rick grew up with a love of sports and the outdoors. He started playing golf at age 3 and continued to excel at it throughout his lifetime. During college, he played baseball at Columbus State University. In 1993, Rick moved to Palm Coast, Florida to be closer to family. 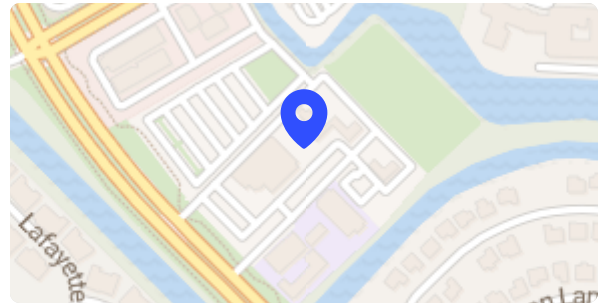

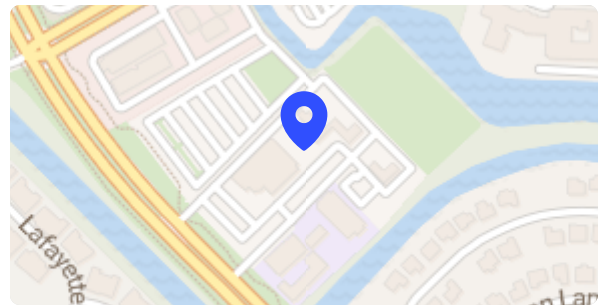

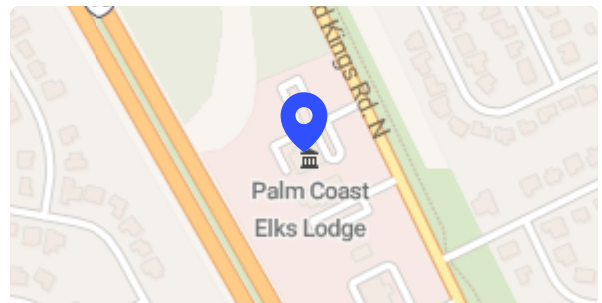
