Scott D. Reedy, 55, passed away unexpectedly in Bunnell, Florida, on September 25, 2021. He was born on February 16th, 1966, in St. Augustine, Florida. A 1984 graduate of St. Joseph's Academy, and later received a Bachelor's in Mathematics from Appalachian State University.

He married his high school sweetheart Lisa Montgomery on December 9, 1989 in St. Augustine.

He worked for FPL for five years, first as a meter reader then air conditioning duct tester. In 1996 he became a Board Certified Pedorthist and opened JSC Pedorthics. Pedorthics was not only a profession, but his calling and ministry. He spent 25 years serving Medicare and Veterans Affairs patients. Scott, along with Lisa, homeschooled their five children. He spent many hours coaching, leading, and mentoring throughout his children's lives in various extracurricular activities. Many families were touched by the generosity that he freely gave.
